**Due to venue size limitations, motor vehicle entries (excluding tractors) will be limited to pre 1992 vehicles (30 years old or earlier).**

### Rally Dinner

**This year's rally dinner will be a very special one – dinner in an Army Mess Tent.**

On Saturday evening we will be offering a catered, two course meal consisting of main course and desert.

The catering will be carried out by Members of the Australian Military Vehicle Museum. The meal will be cooked in a Vietnam Australian Army Cooker and served under Army Canvas.

Diners will be offered a complimentary glass of wine, beer or soft drink. Bookings must be made using the attached entry form. This meal is available to all exhibitors, families, and officials. The price is \$35.00 per adult and \$20.00 per child. We look forward to your company at this informal evening. **No bookings will be taken at the event.**

All profits from the dinner will go to support the Military Vehicle Museum, a very worthwhile cause.

## Motor Vehicle Requirements

Please also note that all motor vehicles including tractors must be registered or have a current permit. Motor vehicles will not be able to be displayed in engine compounds unless they are used to drive exhibits.

## Public Liability Insurance

All persons entering compounds must have current appropriate insurance and be able to produce NHMA public liability insurance card or equivalent if requested. **Please complete the insurance section of the entry form**

## Judging

Entries will be judged on the authenticity of the restoration aligned with the AHMRC judging policy

## Length of Entries

**The allocation of compound space per club is very difficult. To assist in ensuring that all entrants get the required space please make sure that you fill in this item on the form. If the form is left blank then we will make an estimation of the entry length. This will generally be 2 metres. When you calculate the distance you are required to only give us the total length of your display. We will allocate space between your display and other exhibitors.**

## Cancellation

The rally is held on the property of the Mount Barker Council and therefore will be automatically cancelled if either day is declared to be a Catastrophic Fire Day

## Onsite Facilities

Unloading equipment (ramp and forklift), engine water, Friday night and Saturday night security service and fencing are supplied to ensure that you have a "hassle free" weekend.

**Entries** : There are two types of entry:

### Full Entry

Entry is arranged by completing the official entry form. **The entry fee is \$20.00 which covers all the items that any one exhibitor brings along.**

Full entry includes an entry pass for the exhibitor and their partner, a complimentary rally pack with sponsor's products, one rally badge, souvenir programme, tea and coffee vouchers. **To be eligible for trophy judging, the exhibit must be on display for both days of the event and be listed in the souvenir programme.**

Please forward your entry by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022. This will ensure that details of your exhibit are listed in the souvenir program. Early entry also helps in the organisation of the weekend. **Entries received after 1<sup>st</sup> of October may not appear in the Souvenir Program and therefore not judged.** An entry form is attached (add more pages if there is insufficient space for your entries).

### Casual Entry (vehicles only)

No entry form required. Just turn up with an applicable vehicle. (i.e. manufactured prior to 1989)

**The entry fee is \$5 (historic vehicle including driver) \$10 (historic vehicle with passengers) to be paid on the day.** A rally pack including a rally badge is not included. Rally badges will be available at an additional cost from the office.
